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CLARIFICATIONS

Procurement of specialized equipment and supplies for prevention and elimination of flood consequences

REACT/2SOFT/4.2./149/Lot 5

Question 1:

1. In Instruction to tenderers Art. 13 is mentioned: "The implementation of the tasks is maximum 30 days from contract signature".
According to our professional experience this term is very short having in mind the manufacturing procedure, delivery, customs, transport, commissioning. We propose the condition to be "The implementation of the tasks is maximum 90 days from contract signature". Of course, in case of award we will deliver in the shortest term possible.

Answer 1:

By derogation of the art. 1 from Instruction to tenderers, derogation of art. 15 from the Contract notice, the period of implementation of tasks, only for Lot 5.3 (inflatable tents and portable air conditionings) is extended up to maximum 60 days from the contract signature.

Question 2:

2. In Procurement notice Art 17. Award criteria is mentioned: "Price (or, if appropriate after prior approval, the best price-quality ratio which is a combination of quality and price)".
Due the fact that there aren't any technical criteria published in order to make the technical evaluation, we have to understand that the award criteria is price only?

Answer 2:

The award criteria is the price. The financial evaluation will be done only for tenderers which pass the technical evaluation, meaning that the offers received must at least strictly comply to the minimum requirements specified in the technical specifications document.

Question 3:

3. In Procurement notice Art 23. Additional information is mentioned: "Travel expenses related to the purchase of the specialized equipment to the Republic of Moldova, if the case, will be covered by the Contracting Authority" but in the Instruction to tender Art. 1 Supplies to be provided is mentioned DAP INCOTERMS 2010.

We have to understand that the required delivery condition is only DAP INCOTERMS 2010?

Answer 3:

As mentioned in art. 23 of the Contract notice, the travel expenses related to the purchase of the specialized equipment to the Republic of Moldova, if the case, will be covered by the Contracting Authority.

Question 4:

4. In Instruction to tenderers Article 25.2 Inspection and testing is mentioned:" Prior to the final reception, the products will be tested. All types of tests will be performed prior to the final reception, the products will be tested. All types of tests will be performed: The Contracting Authority shall immediately notify the supplier in writing of the identity of its authorized representatives to carry out the surrender, tests and inspections. The inspections and tests performed will be made at the destination of the goods commonly agreed between the Contractor and the Contracting Authority".

Are we to understand that a reception / commissioning meeting will be held at the deliver time at the final location to check quality and conformity of the goods and our technicians must be presents at the location to do complete the job and to offer technical information? In this respect we must evaluate travel, accommodation, and professional costs and to include all these in the offer. Please confirm!

Answer 4:

The Contracting Authority is ready to take over the goods from the bidder's country of origin (in case such an offer will be selected), the delivery-receipt procedure will be performed at the bidder's residence by the specialists of the Contracting Authority.

Question 5:

5. According to our professional experience, the tents as part of an EU program must be provided with visibility elements, as the Program LOGO and the Beneficiary LOGO. We did not find any mentions regarding this request.

Please clarify if the tents will be provided with visual identity of the Procurement program LOGO and Beneficiary LOGO. In case of affirmative answer please provide those LOGOs in pdf.

Answer 5:

The supplies delivered under the EU funded actions must bear the visibility elements according to the Communication and Visibility Manual of the programme.

The visual identity elements (i.e. logo, etc.) will be provided to the selected tenderer.

Question 6:

6. From a technical point of view please read and accept our proposals to complete the technical requirements which describe a specific model of tent which is not the best one we can offer with requirements allowing the offering of a military, versatile, high quality model having higher qualities.

Answer 6:

The Contracting Authority cannot pronounce on the technical specifications offered by any tenderer.

Nota bene: The green and orange color for the exterior of the tents as well as the zippers for the doors, will be considered an advantage.
